

HACAC Membership Options

All members, individuals and institutions, must be in agreement with the purposes of HACAC and the National Association for College Admission Counseling (NACAC) and in agreement with the Statement of Principles of Good Practice. (For the list of Statements go to: www.nacac.com/policies.html)

Hawai'i Individual Voting Members: \$20.00 per membership year

Individuals with responsibility for counseling, admissions and financial aid services and who are employed by state or regionally accredited, not for profit, Hawai'i secondary schools, two and four-year colleges and universities. Independent counselors in Hawai'i, who are members of NACAC, who provide postsecondary education counseling, admission or financial aid services or whose primary activities consist of providing information or services related to those activities. Retired individuals in Hawai'i who were actively engaged in counseling, admission, or financial aid services with HACAC and/or NACAC member institutions, or who were voting members of HACAC and/or NACAC, and in each case, no longer working full time to provide counseling, admission, or financial aid services.

In keeping with HACAC bylaws and articles of incorporation, educational agencies, organizations and other groups in Hawaii qualify for Individual membership only and not Institutional membership.

***Hawai'i Institutional Voting Members: \$45.00 per membership year**

Secondary schools, two-year and four-year colleges and universities in Hawai'i which are not for profit and are accredited by a state or regional accrediting agency, and which are in agreement with the purposes of HACAC and NACAC.

NOTE: HACAC has received requests to allow multiple Institutional memberships for Academic Institutions. In August 2004 the HACAC Executive Board, in keeping with standard practices, decided to maintain the current practice of allowing only one Institutional membership for each institution. HACAC does encourage unlimited Individual memberships from each organization, agency or institution. Each Institutional membership shall have a maximum of three members.

***Associate Nonvoting Individual Members (out of state): \$30.00 per membership year**

Individuals, Institutions, organizations and agencies outside of Hawaii who would satisfy one of the criteria for membership listed above.

Associate Nonvoting Individual College Student Members \$10.00 per membership year

College students seeking careers in counseling, admission, or financial aid services.

Associate Nonvoting Individual Retired Members (out of state) \$10.00/membership year

Retired individuals outside of Hawaii who would satisfy one of the criteria for membership listed above.

*Each Institutional Membership shall have a maximum of three voting members.
Each institution may have only one Institutional membership and
unlimited Individual Memberships.
